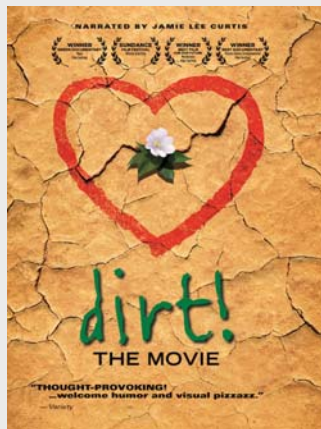


Saturday, October 29
